SD DANR 319 Segment 10 – Justin Krajewski reviewed the budget summary with amendments, Contract/Project summary, 3 pivot projects complete, 8 projects approved and in progress, Range/Riparian projects, 1 complete and 6 approved and in progress, of note, waiting on NRCS cost list

**NRCS Update** – Valerie working on CSP renewals, EQIP rankings working from smaller to larger fund pools, Tyler working on CSP, 8 EQIP and sorting through 120 applications and waiting on the cost list to rank and obligate contracts

**GFP** – seeding projects, access and habitat programs available, wire winder will be available for those removing woven wire, currently have 12 Biologists in the state

USGS – reported on a new stream gauge in Annie Creek in Spearfish Canyon, Whitewood Creek in Deadwood, there are 61 stream gauges with federal priority, 40 of which are funded, criteria for federal priority are flood, drought and land use

**Tanse, NRCS** – Tanse reported on the use of the watershed demo trailer, between Aug 2022 and Sept 2023, 33 presentations and approximately 600 contacts, highlight presentation to the Leadership Cohort for the Belle Fourche Economic Development, Tanse suggested developing a 2 page guide for set up and operation of the trailer for demos.
